

STUDENT PARTICIPATION

1. "Your academy"

It is very important to us and in line with our educational philosophy that our students play a significant role in the design and further development of CIU Korntal. Their experiences from professional and intercultural practice play an important role in the learning community. At the same time, in the context of adult education, we also expect our students to share and take responsibility for their studies.

Ideas, suggestions for improvement and criticism are welcome in personal discussions with the student advisors or the Dean.

2. Course representatives

At the beginning of each course, course representatives are elected, who act as a link between the student body, the professor and the administration. Course representatives meet once per on-campus-period with an administrator to share concerns, questions, praise and to receive updates from the leadership team on new developments. Course representatives should have completed at least three courses at CIU Korntal (exception: Mission and Methods of Theology). This ensures that they are familiar with studying at Korntal, its staff, faculty and leadership team.

3. Course Feedback

At the end of each course, every course participant is asked to provide anonymous course feedback via Moodle. This feedback and evaluation is analyzed and processed as part of quality management. In this way, the courses will be continuously developed and adapted to the interests and needs of the students.

4. Annual Surveys

Another important feedback option for students is the various online surveys. These include surveys for all active students, new students, graduates and alumni. These surveys ask specifically for suggestions for improvement, course requirements or satisfaction with support, service and provision of resources, among other things.
